Ted Reeve Community Arena Vaccination Policy

Starting September 22, 2021, all visitors (spectators, players/permit holders) to Ted Reeve Community Arena recreational facilities who are age 12 years and older will be required to be fully vaccinated.

However, there is an exemption from this requirement if the patron is under 18 years of age and is entering the indoor premises of a facility used for sports and recreational fitness activities solely for the purpose of actively participating in an organized sport, as further described with the Ministry's Guidance.

Individuals are considered fully vaccinated after receiving the full series of a COVID-19 vaccine or combination of COVID-19 vaccines approved by the World Health Organization (e.g. two doses of a two-dose vaccine series, or one dose of a single-dose vaccine series, plus 14 days from last shot).

Proof of vaccination will be required at entry, along with photo ID (such as driver's licence or health card).

Exemptions will be permitted for unvaccinated individuals with medical exemptions or under 12 years of age.

Individuals who cannot receive the vaccine due to medical exemptions will be permitted entry with a doctor's note until recognized medical exemptions can be integrated as part of a digital vaccine receipt.

An enhanced digital vaccine receipt that features a QR code will be available by the Province of Ontario as of October 22.
